Thank you for expressing an interest in our Scholarship Program.

To be eligible to receive a NCMJGSA collegiate academic scholarship, the following requirements must be met:

- (1) Graduate from High School with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 or better.
- (2) Receive a General Education Diploma (GED) with a GPA of 2.0 or better.
- (3) Be accepted and enrolled as a full-time student with twelve (12) or more credit hours at an Accredited College or University of his/her choice.
- (4) Be accepted and registered as a full-time student at an accepted Trade or Vocational School.
- (5) To keep the scholarship for five (5) years or graduation, one must continue to be a full-time student and maintain the GPA of 2.0 or better. If the student fails to be a full-time student or maintain the required GPA he/she will be allowed one (1) probationary semester to bring his/her credit hours and GPA to the acceptable levels or he/she will not qualify for additional assistance.
